



RE: COVID-19 FULL VACCINATION POLICY

The Ontario Government has indicated that as of September 22, 2021 valid proof of COVID-19 vaccination will include either the paper or PDF vaccine receipt (*received following 2nd shot*) along with a government-issued photo ID. As a small business we have put procedures in place to adhere to government wishes as penalties have been put in place for businesses that do not comply to the best of their ability.

WEDDINGS & SPECIAL EVENTS

Event organizers are required to provide a list of every guest attending the wedding or special event to their event coordinator at least a week prior to the event taking place. This contact information should include a first and last name plus a valid phone number or email address in the event the guest will need to be contacted.

On the day of the wedding or special event, all guests are required to enter through the front main entrance of our building where staff members will be present to check and confirm that:

- guests that are fully vaccinated (two doses plus 14 days) must provide their proof of vaccination along with photo identification.
- guests that are NOT VACCINATED or have had ONE VACCINE must provide a NEGATIVE rapid COVID-19 test taken within 48 hours of the event. *This method is only available until October 12th 2021. After that point, the government states that all attendees must be fully vaccinated in order to attend event.*

Please arrive early to your event and do not forget to bring your proof of being fully vaccinated and proof of identification (such a driver's licence).

Royal Ashburn Golf Club staff members will be onsite when guests arrive to the front doors (main entrance) and will be required to confirm that all guests in attendance are fully vaccinated and have provided proof along with valid photo identification. Anyone who is not fully vaccinated will be required to leave.

The Ontario Government has stated that businesses enforcing the province's COVID-19 vaccine certificate system will not have to verify medical exemptions.

If you are attending an outdoor ceremony or outdoor reception, full vaccination of COVID-19 is not required. The policies for physical distancing and mask wearing requirements still apply based on capacities.



RESTAURANT ACCESS / BUTLER'S PUB & GRILL

Reservations are required in order to dine in Butler's Pub & Grill restaurant. Every guest wishing to dine indoors or outdoors must please contact our PRO SHOP to reserve your table (905) 686-1121 x 1.

All guests with a restaurant reservation are asked to sign in upon arrival in our restaurant (Butler's Pub & Grill). There will be a designated sign-in to dine-in area. All guests will be required to sign-in prior to being seated and will be asked to provide their full name, phone number and time of entry. Once seated please ensure you have your full vaccination passport and valid photo identification ready for a Royal Ashburn Golf Club server to validate. *Please do not forget to bring with you, proof of being fully vaccinated and proof of identification (such a driver's licence) or you will be asked to dine outdoors (weather permitting).*

- Guests that are NOT VACCINATED or have had ONE VACCINE must provide a NEGATIVE rapid COVID-19 test taken within 48 hours of the event. *This method is only available until October 12th 2021. After that point, the government states that all attendees must be fully vaccinated in order to dine indoors.*

Full vaccination of COVID-19 is not required for outdoor dining. The policies for physical distancing and mask wearing requirements still apply.

GOLF & PRO SHOP

Golfers are not required to show proof of full vaccination when checking in for their round of golf, but they are required to check-in with the pro-shop for their scheduled tee-time.

No proof of full vaccination is required when using the washroom facilities or while shopping in the pro shop. The policies for physical distancing and mask wearing requirements still apply.

Golfers can enter our restaurant to pick up and pay for their grab and go food and beverage items to take back outdoors. If golfers would like to sit indoors and dine after or before their round they are required to make a reservation with the pro shop in advance and follow the same protocol as those wishing to dine in, as stated above.
